

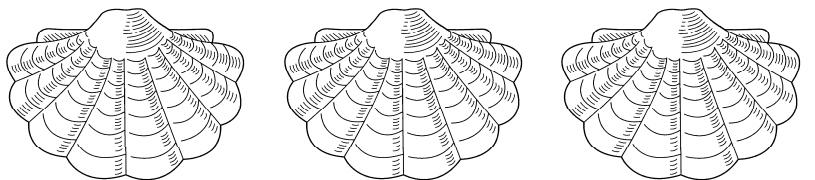






FOOD FOR BODY, MIND AND SPIRIT
